

Internship Activity Timeline for the Accelerated (AMAT/AMTMS/ARCSE) Routes

May be modified according to the needs and demands of your classroom.

August

- Internship formally begins 8/26
- Before school starts, read the Blueprint List of Internship Activities and Internship Activity Timeline
- Work with mentor to set up classroom, plan curricula for the year, attend school and district in-service, etc.

September

- Intern observes instruction and classroom management
- Intern works one-on-one with a student or with small groups of students to supplement instruction
- Intern visits other classrooms to observe various teaching environments
- September Release Day - 9/27

October

- Begin teaching (non-content rich) lessons to practice classroom management and communication strategies
- Begin to experiment the various co-teaching strategies
- First reflection due to supervisor by 10/15
- October Release Day - 10/25

November

- Teach content rich, standards-based lessons, with the whole class, with advisement of mentor
- edTPA orientation 11/14, 5-6:30, on-campus; location TBD
- November Release Day - 11/22

December

- Take primary responsibility for planning and instruction in one subject area (elementary), or 1-2 periods (secondary)
- Second reflection due to supervisor by 12/15

January

- Over the next six weeks, assume more responsibility each week as appropriate
- Evidence of growth and readiness to teach is documented by mentor and university supervisor
- edTPA Task 1 workshop, 1/18, 10:00-4:00, on-campus; location TBD
- January Release Day - 1/24

February

- By the time midwinter break is over, intern assumes full-time responsibility for planning, instruction and assessment
- Mentor co-teaches according to the strategies agreed upon
- edTPA Task 2 and 3 workshop, 2/22, 10:00-4:00, on-campus – location TBD
- February Release Day 2/28

March through April

- Full time independent teaching (for a total of 10-12 weeks)
- Third reflection due to supervisor by 3/15
- March Release Day/edTPA writing day, 3/27, 10-4, on-campus; location TBD
- Optional EdTPA Writing Retreat at Camp Casey: 4/3- 4/5. Cost is \$55. Students who sign up will be granted an excused absence on 4/3 only if they are at Camp Casey by 9 am.
- April Release Day/ edTPA writing day, 4/24, 10-4, on-campus; location TBD

May

- Full time independent teaching, gradually releasing lead responsibility back to mentor
- edTPA due 5/7

June

- Co-teaching, mentor in the lead role
- The final day of internship is the last day of the K-12 school year

*Note: In general, the release days are set aside for release from internship to focus on coursework and other tasks. If that date does not work for your internship, you may schedule with your mentor another date that suits your situation better. The edTPA writing days are designed to provide structured support on campus for students. They may be swapped for two *different* days released from internship if that is better for your schedule, but the total days off should not exceed two.

Supervisor Visits:

Fall Quarter: 4-5 visits

Winter Quarter: 4-5 visits

Spring Quarter: 2-3 visits
