- Update on PEAB workgroup on standards, approvals, and review
- Clarity and guidance regarding the minimum standards surrounding endorsements for post-baccalaureate/graduate students. WAC 181-79A-030 regarding 45 credits in an endorsement /content area.
- PESB to create a user guide available for programs by June 2018. The purpose of this user guide would be to give new programs some form of induction/guidance from PESB regarding WACs. This would also serve as reference for certification officers who need guidance on WAC.
- Since Time Immemorial requirement in WAC. The question was raised if the material is imbedded in curriculum or if a specific course is required regarding Washington state government/history.
