- * Convenes January 10th
- * Lasts 60 Days
- * Bills that did not pass this year are still alive
- * Likely (but not certain) to be all or mostly virtual
- * Senate currently prohibiting members/staff from accessing buildings without vaccine confirmation
 - * Key Cards de-activated without confirmation
 - * Senators meeting today, may decide on form of session

PESB Agenda

- Scale "Grow Your Own" programs, such as Recruiting Washington Teachers and Alternative Routes, to improve teacher recruitment.
- Remove barriers impacting para-educators entering the teaching profession.

PESB Agenda

- * Enhance preparation program review to ensure all educators, regardless of role, are prepared with the skills and mindset to support the success of all students.
- Develop bridge programs to increase preparation program completion rates among candidates of color.
- Pilot year-long residency models to increase retention among early-career professionals.

PESB Agenda

- * Incentivize collaborative community partnerships to address regional workforce needs.
- * Expand grant programs that strengthen learning communities to support educator retention.
- Reduce educator turn-over rates with effective, equity-centered HR practices.

PESB Agenda

* Leverage the existing strengths and authority of our agency to advance legislative goals such as masterybased learning, language access, and educational equity system-wide.

OSPI

- Prioritizing Adding School Nurses\$27M/year through 2024

 - \$100M/year 2025 ->
 - Schools would be allowed to use for other ESA's if they have enough nurses
 - School Social Workers proposing office within OSPI to support their work and encourage more social workers in schools to address social/emotional needs. (\$150,000/year)
