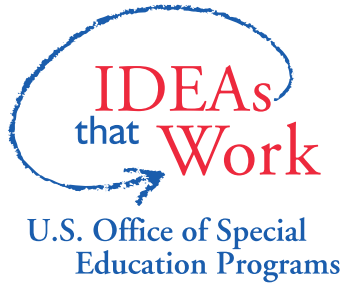

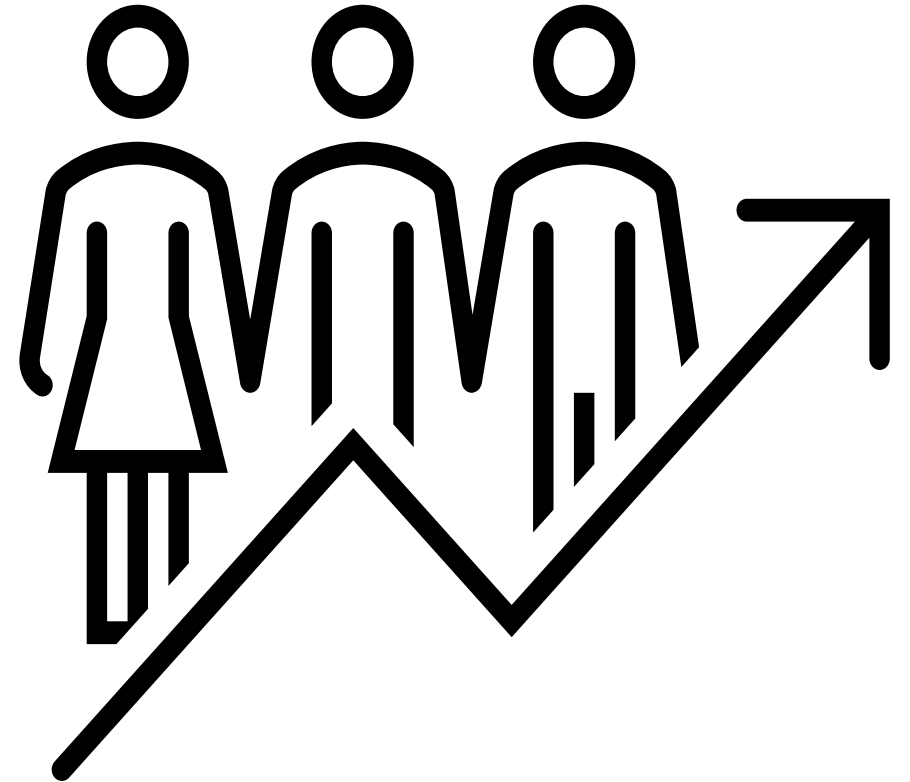

- Break down the siloes between SpEd and General Education
- Elevate and Amplify conversations on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion for all learners
- Center work on all learners, especially those who have experienced marginalization
