How do these assessment system components fit with PESB's strategic priorities, specifically goals 1, goal 2, Goals 3. The West B is a financial barrier and does not have a meaningful purpose. Prospective students are pushing back on having to pay \$100 for a test that is not part of admissions considerations. And since WEST is a NOT a diagnostic tool, programs need to be careful about manufacturing a reason to consider the WEST-B.
